People often asked me why I want to be both a Roman Catholic priest and a physician. Humbly I would respond: it is my way to say thanks to God for the many blessings and in turn to share them with other people. I am thankful for the gift of life as I was among the only 70 survivors out of 300 in a destiny boat sunk while escaping the suppressive Communist regime to seek freedom. I am thankful for the gift of inner strength and mental single-mindedness to survive an 18-month ordeal of poverty, poor sanitation, lack of basic medical care in a remote refugee camp in the rural part of Hong Kong. I feel profoundly thankful for the opportunity to be in the United States and the gift of intellectual curiosity and perseverance to overcome many obstacles so far in my adopted homeland. As a priest, I am responding to God's gifts by sharing them with other people - particularly the poor, less fortunate, and oppressed people. Through my religious teaching, I hope to help my fellow humans recognized these gifts of love in their lives as well. As a priest with the vows of poverty and celibacy, I can devote to serve others more fully, to give more freely, to love more deeply, without any reservations, family obligations or financial concerns.

Moreover, I am also a physician because I have realized the valuable and effective service of medicine to humanity. I cannot simply preach to people about love, but must also show them examples of God's love by treating their illnesses, relieving their suffering, or at least, providing some physical comfort to their pains. I cannot just preach about hope, but must also afford first some means to get them back to some sense of normalcy, or at least some hope for an improved condition. I cannot simply verbally encourage people to contribute toward the improvement of our world from my church's pulpit, but must lead by example, by devoting my medical knowledge and skills to the physical healing process.
