Craig Spellman, Ph.D., D.O., is an Associate Professor of Medicine, Head of Endocrinology, Director of the Diabetes Center and Assistant Dean for the Dual Degree Programs at UNT. He has been teaching students for over 30 years. Dr. Spellman has more than 60 publications on insulin therapy and type 2 diabetes, CV risk in Hispanic children, and lipid treatment in type 2 DM. He has made more than 250 presentations nation-wide. Dr. Spellman has also received several teaching awards at UNT.
