Dedication

Lt. General Ronald R. Blanck, D.O., (U.S. Army, retired) has served as president of UNTHSC in Fort Worth for the past 5 years. He is retiring this year so he can be closer to his family on the East Coast.

As president, Dr. Blanck oversees a growing academic health center that includes the Texas College of Osteopathic Medicine, Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences and School of Public Health. More than 190 full-time faculty and 300 volunteer community physicians work with nearly 1,000 students who are training to be osteopathic physicians, researchers, public health officers, physician assistants and other health professionals.

During Blanck's tenure, enrollment in the center's schools nearly doubled, research funding tripled, and the size of the campus doubled with the construction of the Center for BioHealth and the purchase of the nearby Osteopathic Medical Center of Texas.

Blanck expanded the center's network of hospital partnerships, opened a center for non-invasive imaging in the Center for BioHealth,

helped bring the first federally funded community health clinic to Fort Worth, and expanded the biotechnology incubator in partnership with the city.

Dr. Blanck continues to be consulted as an advisor on bioterrorism issues and an expert in preparing the medical community to respond to mass casualty incidents or those involving weapons of mass destruction. He now chairs task forces on bioterrorism for both the TMA and the AOA, and was elected to the Board of Managers of the Association of Military Surgeons of the US in March 2006.

Thank you for your dedication to UNTHSC Dr. Blanck, you will be missed by all.



Michael B. Clearfield, D.O., F.A.C.O.I.

Dr. Clearfield is currently Professor of Medicine and Associate Dean for Clinical Research, Office of the Dean, Texas College of Osteopathic Medicine. After 27 years of service to the Health Science Center, Dr. Clearfield will be leaving the institution to assume the role as Dean at the Touro University College of Osteopathic Medicine in Vallejo, California.

Dr. Clearfield joined the faculty of UNTHSC in 1979 following completion of his internal medicine residency. In 1980, he was appointed Vice Chairman of the Department of Internal Medicine and then served as Chairman of the department from 1982-2002. During his tenure as chair of the Department of Medicine, Dr. Clearfield served as course director for both the internal medicine course and clinical clerkship as well as director of the internal medicine residency program. In 2002, he was appointed Associate Dean for Clinical Research and the Osteopathic Heritage Foundation Distinguished Chair in Clinical Research.


Dr. Clearfield currently serves as the AOA's representative to the National Cholesterol Education Program. He was the co-primary

investigator for the Air Force/Texas Coronary Atherosclerosis Prevention Study (AFCAPS/TexCAPS) and was responsible for the TexCAPS component which was done on the campus of UNTHSC. AFCAPS/TexCAPS was the largest primary prevention trial done in the United States relative to the reduction of cholesterol to that of cardiovascular events and was instrumental in the creation of the current Adult Treatment Panel III guidelines for the treatment of cholesterol in this country.



He has been an integral part of the development and success of UNTHSC-TCOM and he will certainly be missed.
